When <u>Charles Darwin</u> visited the Galapagos Islands (in 1859), he noticed how some giant tortoises looked slightly different to each other. On islands that tortoises ate plants close to the ground, the reptiles had rounded shells. On islands that tortoises needed to stretch their necks to eat tall shrubs, the reptiles had shells that bent upwards at the front. Observing adaptations like this, helped Darwin develop his theory of evolution.
