Did You Know?

Crabeater seals are hardy and <u>determined</u> mammals, whose speed and <u>physical</u> agility in the icy waters that surround Antarctica help them evade predators like killer whales and <u>aggressive</u> leopard seals. Despite their name, crabeater seals <u>primarily</u> feed on Antarctic krill. They are among the most populous seals in the world, with an estimated population of around 15 million.
