Did You Know?

Humans are often considered the world's most deadly creatures due to their <u>significant</u> impact on the environment, other species and each other. Rhinos are one of the many <u>species</u> around the world that are critically endangered due to poaching and habitat loss. Rhinos are poached by humans <u>primarily</u> for their horns, which are highly valued in some cultures. For example, in parts of Asia, rhino horns are believed to have <u>medicinal</u> properties, even though there is no scientific evidence to support this.



In 2022, a wildlife reserve recorded 480 poaching incidents. In 2023, new security measures (including anti-poaching patrols) reduced the number of incidents by 75%.
