The Somerset Levels are famous for its starlings. During autumn and winter, millions of starlings <u>gather</u> in the area and create <u>breathtaking</u> displays in the sky, called murmurations. They <u>frequently</u> do this to stay warm, communicate and avoid predators. Starlings occupy the levels in such large numbers because the wetland offers plenty of food and <u>shelter</u> during the colder months.
