## Did You Know?

Dinosaurs dominated the planet for over 160 million years, but their reign ended in disaster 66 million years ago. A massive asteroid, 15 kilometres wide, smashed into Earth near modern-day Mexico. The impact triggered wildfires, tsunamis and earthquakes, sending dust into the atmosphere and blocking sunlight. This disastrous chain of events wiped out most dinosaurs. Only small animals (like early mammals, birds and some reptiles) survived the chaos to reshape Earth's future.
